Ace Pigeon (Best Bird):

1. Will be decided over the last three races – two “Super turbo tosses” and main race.
2. The velocity of every paid bird – calculated at metres/minute – added together over the three races will decide the winner.
3. For this purpose alone, the race will close at exactly 200m/minute after the first paid bird was clocked. This is to prevent any birds being out of contention after one bad race.
4. No bird will obtain a velocity more than 200m/minute slower than the first paid bird clocked in every race

Reserve Birds:

1. A reserve bird cannot compete for any prize money unless activated.
2. A reserve bird can be activated at any stage (paid in full).
3. An activated reserve bird can compete in any competition and prize money after being activated.
4. A team can be strengthened by activating your reserve birds.
5. If an entered bird is lost for 14 days the reserve bird will automatically replace it.
6. If an entered bird is lost prior to any prize money competition the reserve bird will be promoted and become the entered bird immediately.
7. If an entered bird returns after the roles were reversed the roles will stay reversed i.e. entered bird will now be the reserve bird.
8. A team must have two or more fully paid birds to compete in the team competition.
9. If a reserve bird is paid in full (activated), proof of payment must be faxed or e-mailed to our offices for confirmation prior to any prize money race.
10. Reserve birds not activated on or after the last Super Turbo Race will be for sale to other fanciers or the public and may be advertised for sale – to be entered into the main race.

The Auction:

1. The first 100 birds home in the main race will be auctioned on the same day as the prize-giving ceremony.
2. All other birds returning in time will be auctioned at intervals at pre-destined venues. Other fanciers or clubs may apply for pigeons to be auctioned by them, clubs will earn 15% commission.
3. All pigeons will be placed on Dinokeng Loft's Auction Site for pre-bidding.
4. A 50/50 split will occur between the loft and the entrant, after auction and admin costs have been deducted. Non-activated entries and reserves excluded (even if paid by 3rd party). No split for birds selling for R300.00 or less.

Registration:

1. Entry fee: R7000 per entry group (one entry plus two reserves)
2. Registration Fee: R200 per entry group
3. Registration and entry fees must be paid in full before birds can be entered into the loft.
4. A completed registration form as well as proof of payment must be faxed or e-mailed to us.
5. International Entrants can contact us and we will e-mail or fax you your local race coordinator's details (if available).
6. On receiving your entry and payment, we will confirm your registration.
7. Entry fees and prize money payments will be made according to the ZAR rate of exchange.

An Entrant

1. Any person, persons, partnerships etc. who enter pigeons into this loft will be called an entrant.
2. An entrant must enter under one name i.e. Tommy Roux or Tommy + Jean or Mean Team or any name he/she/they prefer. (please keep the name as short as possible)
3. Every entrant must register. The loft can handle only a limited amount of pigeons, register early to avoid disappointment.
4. An entrant can enter as many pigeons as he/she/they want to.
5. An entrant can enter more than one team if he/she/they want to.
6. Every team must be registered under different names i.e. Bullbrand, Bullbrand 2, Bullbrand 3 etc.
7. The first name on the registration form will be the sole spokesperson for that entrée unless otherwise indicated by the entrant.

Entering Birds:

1. South African birds can be entered between the 01 October 2011 – 01 March 2012. International birds from 01 August 2011 - 01 March 2012.
2. At registration the entry and reserves must be identified. Interchanging entry and reserve birds allowed up to 02 July 2012
3. South African and International pigeons lost during orientation period can be replaced but no later than end of February 2012. (NB! When breeding – breed two or three extra birds for this purpose)



Shipment of Birds:

1. Every entrant must make their own arrangements to get their pigeons to the Loft.
2. International entrants can contact the country race co-ordinator (if available-we will furnish contact details) or Dinokeng Lofts for information on permits, health certificates etc. in time to be ready for shipment.
3. Shipment and flight details with entry forms, permits and certificates must reach our offices before or on the same day shipment will take place. (Local fanciers do not need permits and health certificates).

Team Competition

1. To be decided over five (5) races – one toss, three “Super Turbo tosses” and main race
2. The average velocity of any team’s first two (paid) birds home, reached in each separate race, will be added together and the team with the best overall speed will be the winner.
3. A team can only function with two or more paid (activated) pigeons.
4. A team can have reserve pigeons to replace possible lost pigeons.
5. Teams consisting of entry groups (1 entry + 2 reserves) may consist of any number of competitors. These teams must be finalized at registration and no changes will be allowed.
6. A team can consist of any number of entered birds and reserve birds.
7. Reserve birds must be activated (paid) to compete, or can stay in the team to replace any lost paid birds.
8. Every entrant who has two or more paid (activated) pigeons in the same team automatically qualify for the team competition.
9. Every race in the team competition will close at an average speed of 200 m / m i n u t e slower than the average speed of the winning team in every race. This is to prevent any team being out of the competition because of one bad race. This rule will only apply for the team competition.

Make sure you plan your teams in advance to avoid disappointment!

Information and Rules:

1. Pigeons must be rung with 2011/12 recognized identity rings.
2. No pigeon may be entered into our loft more than once.
3. Every pigeon entered will receive an electronic race ring on entry into loft.
4. Vaccinations, medications, feeding, training etc. will be done to the best of our ability to ensure that birds will be in the best possible physical condition.
5. While every possible measure will be taken not to lose any birds during the orientation period, you may replace lost birds up to the end of February 2012.
6. Up to date information concerning all aspects will be displayed on our website.
7. The Loft will not allow any doping, foul play or any discrepancies – every bird in the loft will have exactly the same opportunity to prove its worth. We are committed to honest, ethical and excellent management and believe in fair play at all times.
8. Liberation: Liberation time and close of race will be at the sole discretion of management.
9. Toss and race program will be displayed on our web-site.
10. Pigeons entered into this loft will become the property of Dinokeng Lofts the moment they are entered into the loft.
11. At the conclusion of a specific season, a payment instruction containing different payment options will be sent to prize winners within 10 working days. This document must be fully completed and submitted to us before payment will be processed.
12. Basketing and timing of pigeons on Main Race will be done under observation of the appointed independent auditors (appointed by our accountants or SANPO or both)
13. Fanciers is welcome to be present at basketing of birds.
14. Visitors are welcome to visit the loft on appointment, but must obey the Loft rules.
15. Basketing lists, toss and race results will be displayed on our website.
16. No person/s connected to the loft will be allowed to enter pigeons.
17. Partnerships can be formed with other fanciers, family, friends, the public and even businesses.
18. Pigeons entered into the loft must be entered in a ratio of one entered and two reserve pigeons to qualify for the lost team ruling (Entry Group). Registration & entry fee must be paid.
19. If an entered pigeon and the two reserves are lost prior to the final race and before winning any prize money, a free entry for the next year will be given.
20. Activated reserve pigeons do not qualify for a free entry if lost. To compensate for this rule an entrant will qualify for one free entry for every four paid (activated) birds. This rule will be revised every year.
